

## Test of Edison Auto Battery.

BOSTON, Mass. Aug. 18.—President Edgar of the Edison Company of Boston tested the new Edison battery yesterday by attaching it to his automobile for endurance. On one charge the battery ran seventy-five miles at an average of fifteen miles an hour. It was practically in constant use from 3:30 P. M. to 11 P. M. without a recharge.
